Suggestions for Improvement:	Abby deliver the content efficiently with the use of technology, but what I appreciated is that at the same time she was engaging students to participate through interesting questions that provoked the students reflection and analysis. For example, when a student asked Abby a question, instead of giving the answer. She refer back to the article and provided a portion of it, that way students could infer the answer. In another occasion, Abby provided the answer without asking other students or a choral response.  She introduced high vocabulary in her teaching, while providing the meaning to the students through the context.  Abby should be visiting all students while they are working in an assignment to make sure they do not have any questions.

Suggestions for Improvement:	Abby has good teacher's presence and voice. Her interactions with students and practicum teacher were all positive and respectful. Also, she delivered the lesson at a good pace. She devoted time to explain in detail to students and allow the to process the information and ask questions.  Abby should have equal proximity with students at all times and be consistent in the procedures. She remained the majority of the time in the front of the classroom.
